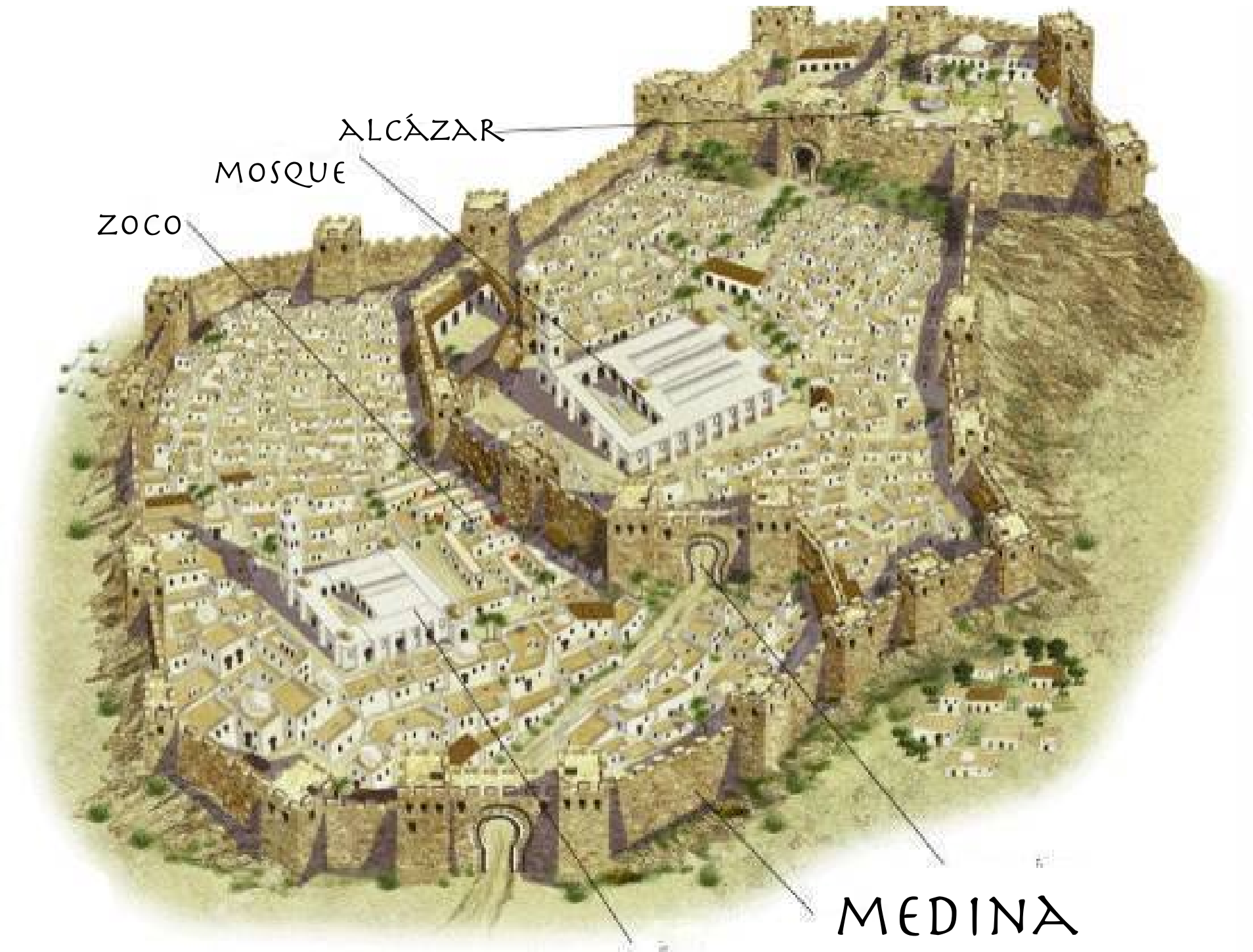

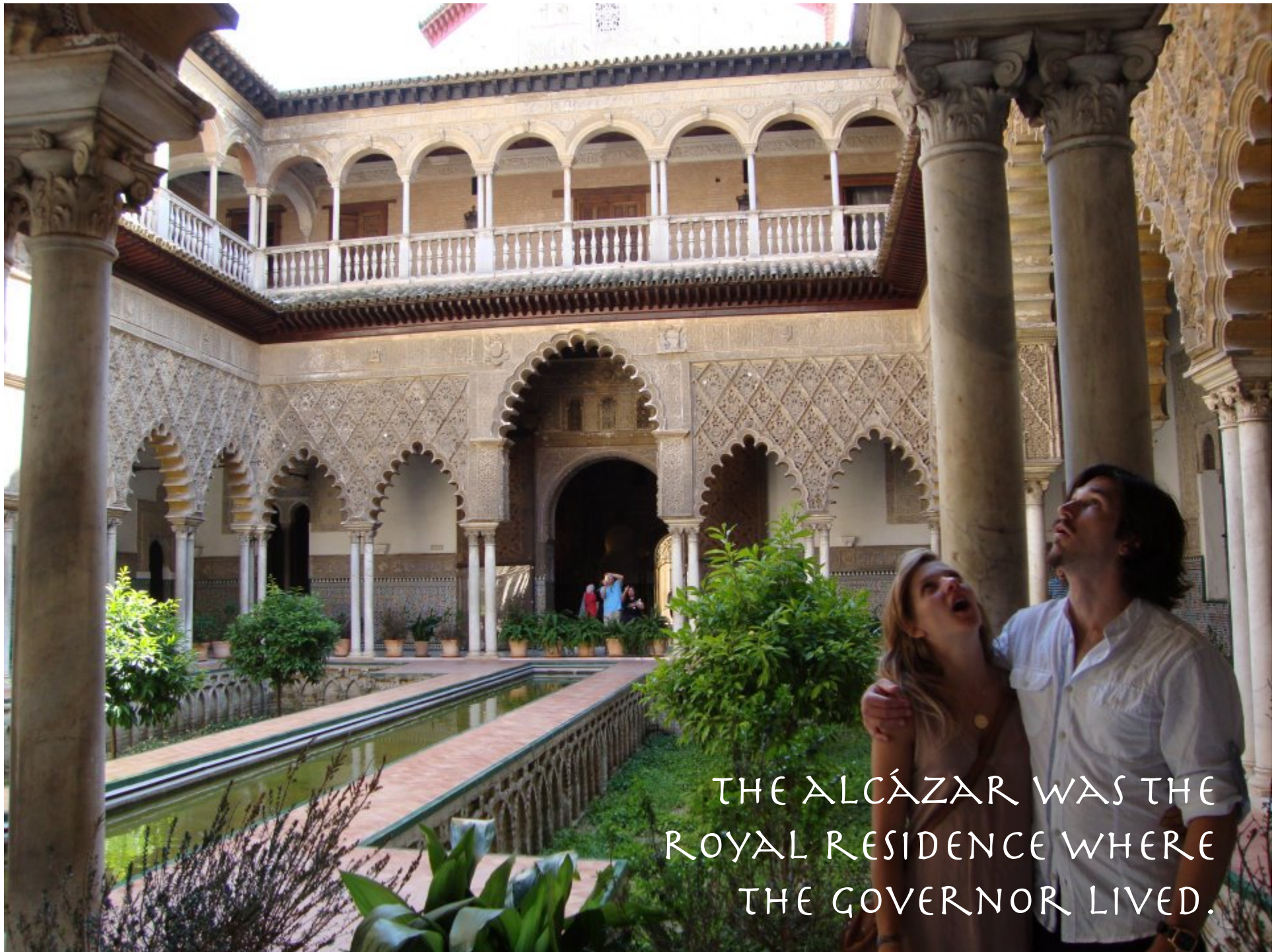

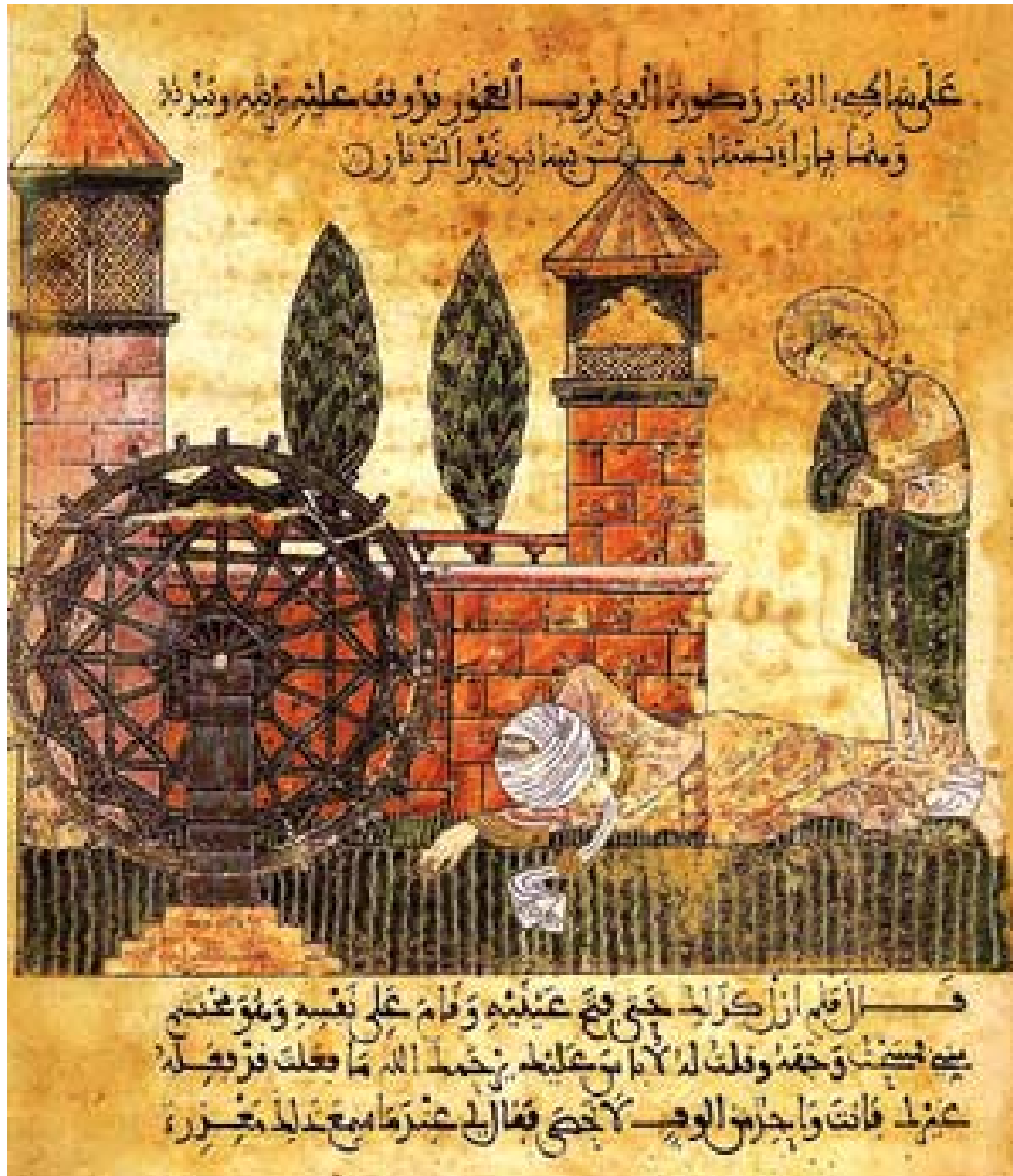

THE ECONOMY OF AL-ANDALUS DEPENDED HEAVILY ON TRADE.

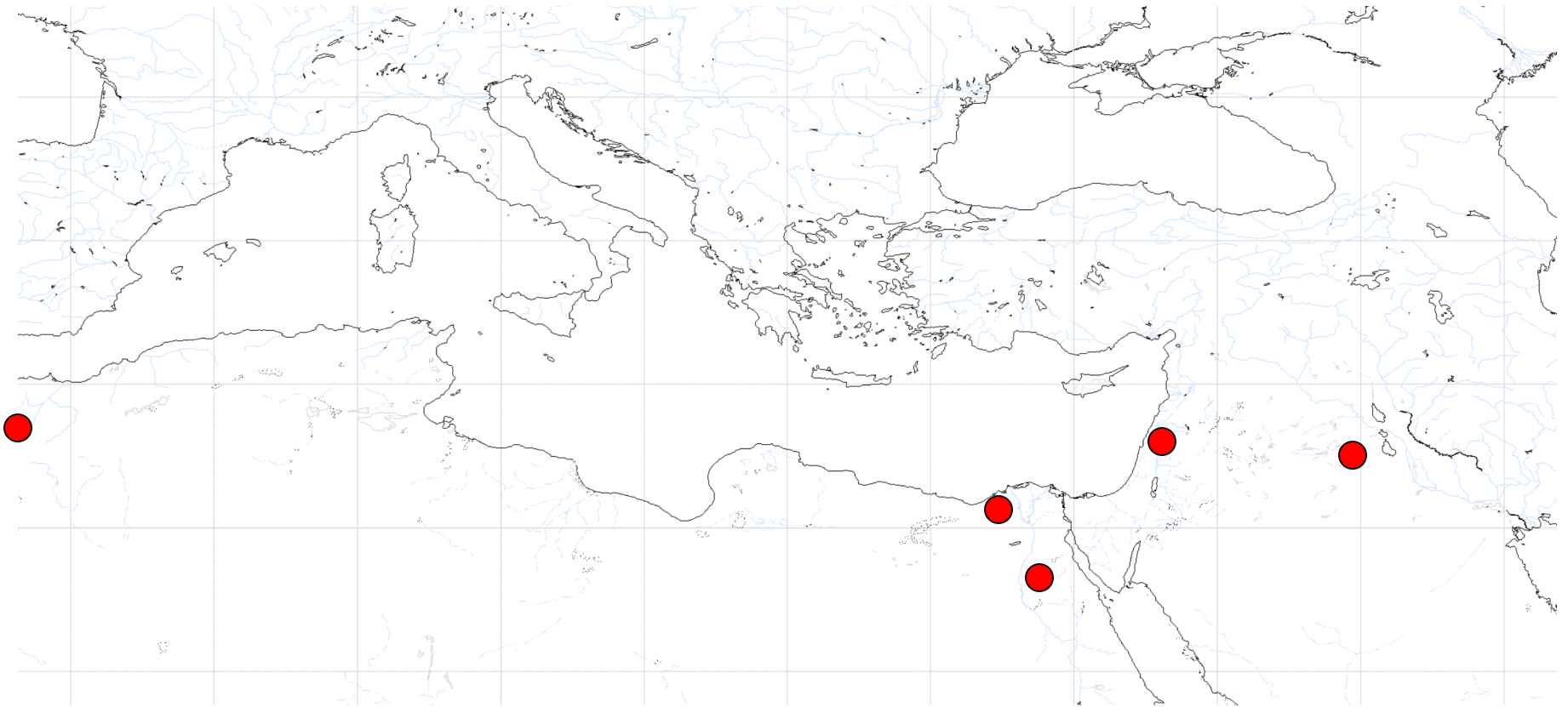




CARAVANS
